

Linda Roemisch-Learning the Art of Pastels Class- Material List

Please bring these items to our class:

A picture or drawing of something you would love to paint.

Pastel Paper: 2 small 9x12 (but no smaller) or a size you feel best practicing on (please keep in mind you are not here to create a master piece but to learn technique). This exercise will be done on light colored or white pastel paper.

Pastel paper that accepts wet media such as: Art Spectrum Colourfix Uart Multi Media Art Board Ampersand Richeson Gator Foam Premium Pastel Premier sanded paper

Pastels: Hard and soft pastels not chalk. If you are purchasing new pastels look for specials online, a small starter set is fine. A hard pastel dark red or purple such as nu-pastel or charcoal vine or a pencil for drawing.

Those who want to do an underpainting using watercolor bring: Small inexpensive watercolor set or just three small tubes of the 3 primary colors and an old inexpensive brush does not have to be a watercolor brush size 6-10 (not one used for oil painting) and a small container that holds water, it can be a clean recycled plastic container, make it simple.

Those who want to do an underpainting using alcohol bring: 1-small bottle of 70% Isopropyl Alcohol 1 –additional old inexpensive brush size 6-10 (not one used for oil painting) and a small container that holds water, it can be a clean recycled plastic container, make it simple. You are also encouraged to bring your iPads or laptops to work from. NOTE: there is no wifi at the location.
